
#### **Directions to Glenwood Elementary School**

Take the Chatham exit (Exit 88), turn west and follow the frontage road as it curves south, 1 mile to Chatham Road. Turn west on Chatham Road, 1.8 miles to Gordon Drive. Turn north, 34 mile to Plummer Blvd. Turn west on Plummer to elementary school parking lot.

#### From Highway 4:

Turn east on Plummer Blvd. at north edge of Chatham. Follow Plummer 34 mile to elementary school.
